

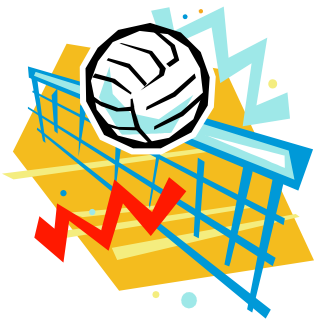
PARTICIPATION IN EXTRA-CURRICULAR EVENTS

Attendance at and participation in extra-curricular events at Benjamin Middle School is considered a privilege. In order to participate in any extra-curricular or after school event, a student must be in attendance that entire day. This does not apply to field trips or prearranged absences for doctor or dentist appointments, prearranged school visits, or religious requirements. If the absence is due to unusual circumstances, permission to participate may be requested from the principal.



PROCEDURES FOR HOME GAMES

- Between 2:45 & 4:00 P.M., students who are with a coach will be the only students permitted in the building.
- After 4:00 P.M. on the days that home games are scheduled, students and other spectators will be allowed only in the gym and lobby area.



- Spectators will be admitted to the gym at 3:55 P.M. on the day of a game. Spectators are expected to remain seated in the bleachers at all times. A supervisor will be stationed at the southeast and southwest entrances to the gym. Spectators will be allowed in or out of the gym only during timeouts.
- Food, drink (except water), candy, and gum are prohibited from the gymnasium. Any of these substances can do damage to the finish on the playing surface.
- Since dirt from shoes can create a slippery, unsafe playing surface, at no time shall spectators cross the playing area. This includes before and after games. Spectators are not to use the basketballs.
- Spectators not watching the game and interfering with the right of others to watch the game will be required to leave the building.
- Hats are to be worn facing forward by students and adults.
- Students are not allowed to return to their lockers for coats, books, etc.
- Parking will only be allowed in designated paved parking areas. When the back lot is full, additional cars must park in the front lot only – please NO parking on the grass areas due to septic issues. There is additional parking in the church lot.

Students are to be picked up no later than 10 minutes after the activity has concluded. If a student is not picked up in the appropriate time, future game attendance will be jeopardized.

Basketball Games –

Just a Reminder-----Parents and siblings only, may attend 6th grade basketball games! There is no supervision provided, so other students will not be allowed at these games. If students arrive without parents, they will be informed that they will need to leave.
